Page1

[Alt + Tab](#)

Is handy for toggling [switching] between open but minimized Windows on your Desktop.

The WinKey or “Windows Logo” key [usually between the Ctrl and the Alt keys] is a handy key for:

[WinKey + D](#) Shows\Hides the Desktop

[WinKey + F](#) Finds [or Searches for] Files, Folders

[WinKey + F1](#) Opens Windows Help

[WinKey + R](#) Opens the Run dialog box

[WinKey + Tab](#) Cycles through TaskBar program [the opened but minimized programs at the bottom of your screen.

[WinKey + E](#) Opens an Explorer window

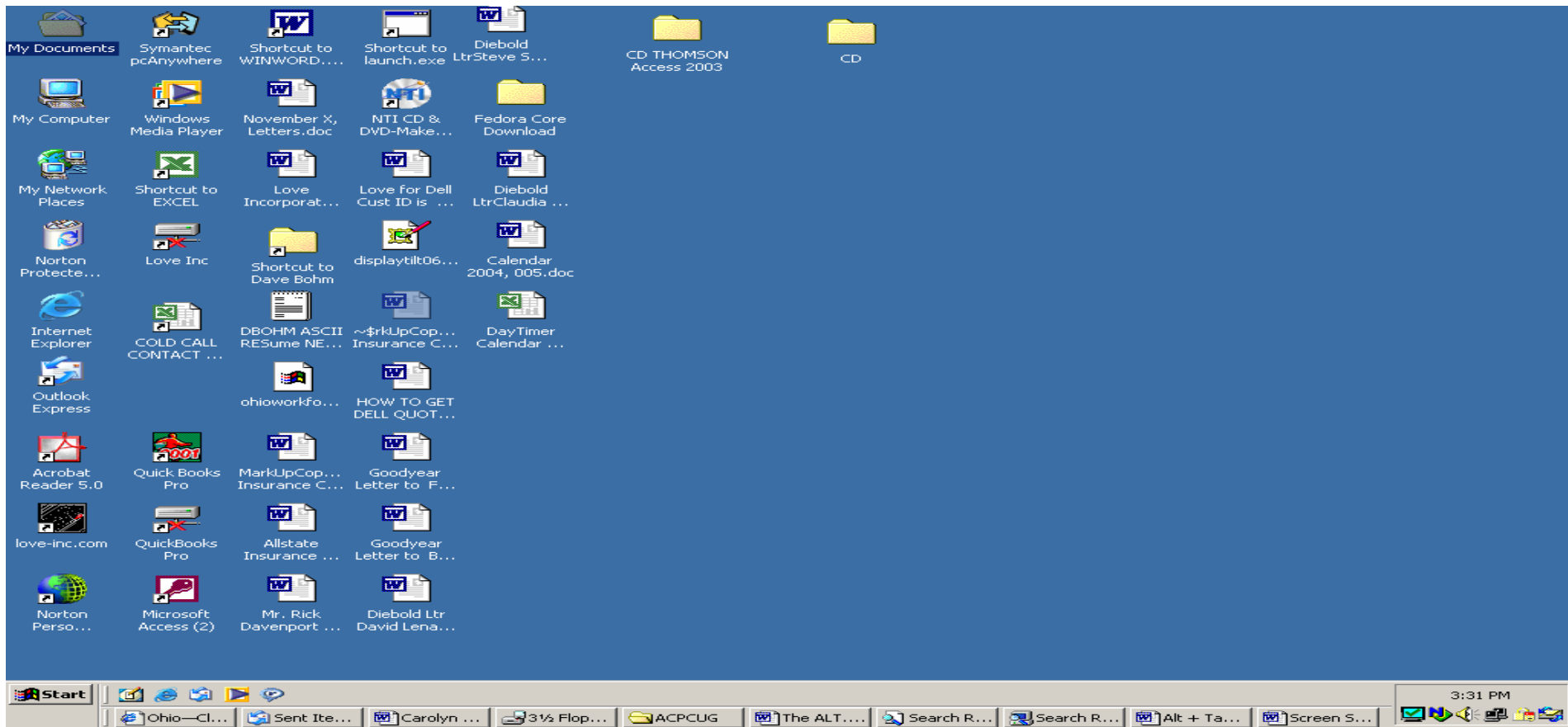
[WinKey + Ctrl + F](#) Find [Search for] Computer [other computers on your network]

WinKey + M Minimizes all

WinKey + Shift + M Undoes minimize above

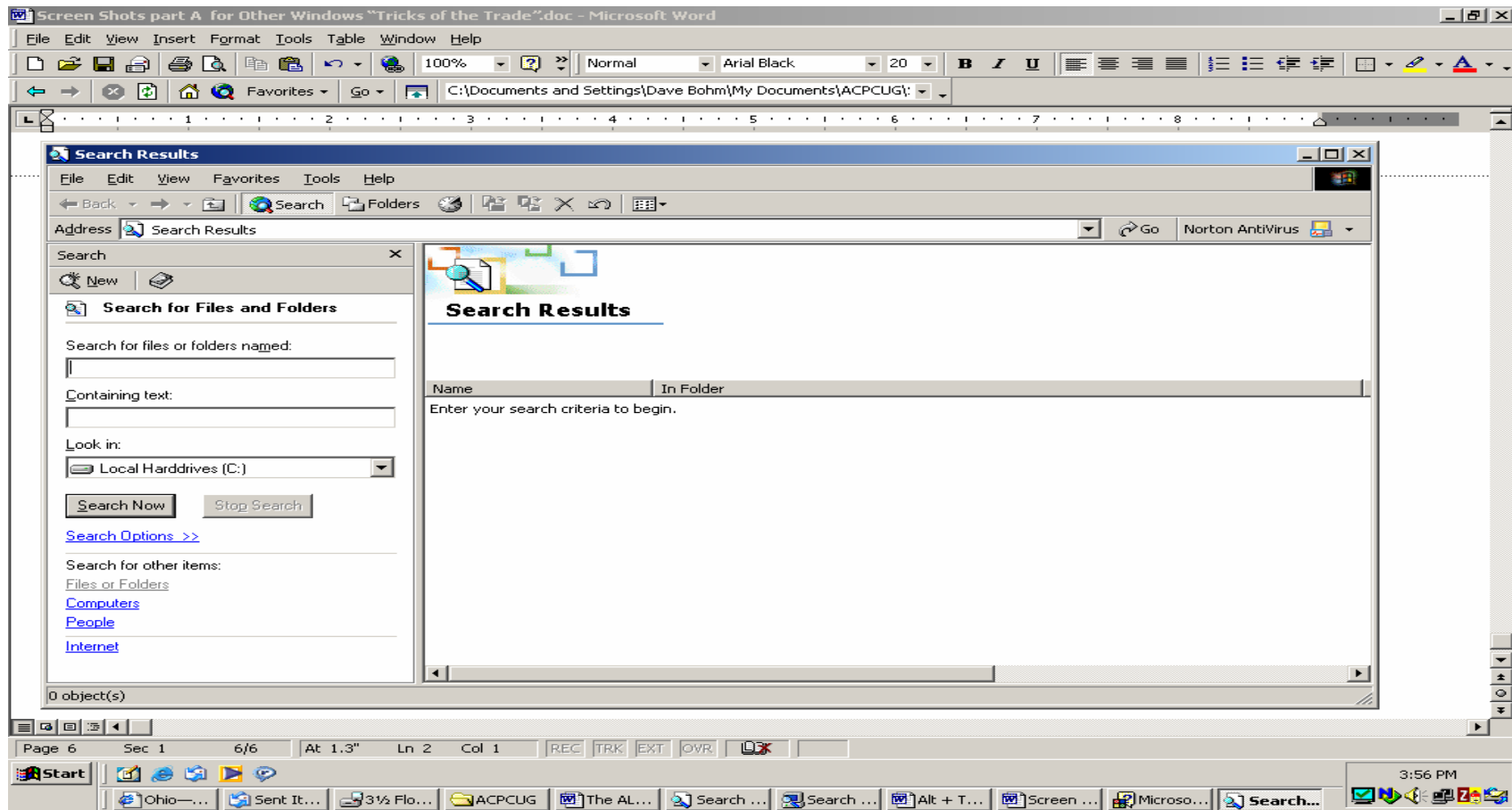
Alt + Tab

Is handy for toggling [switching] between open but minimized Windows on your Desktop.

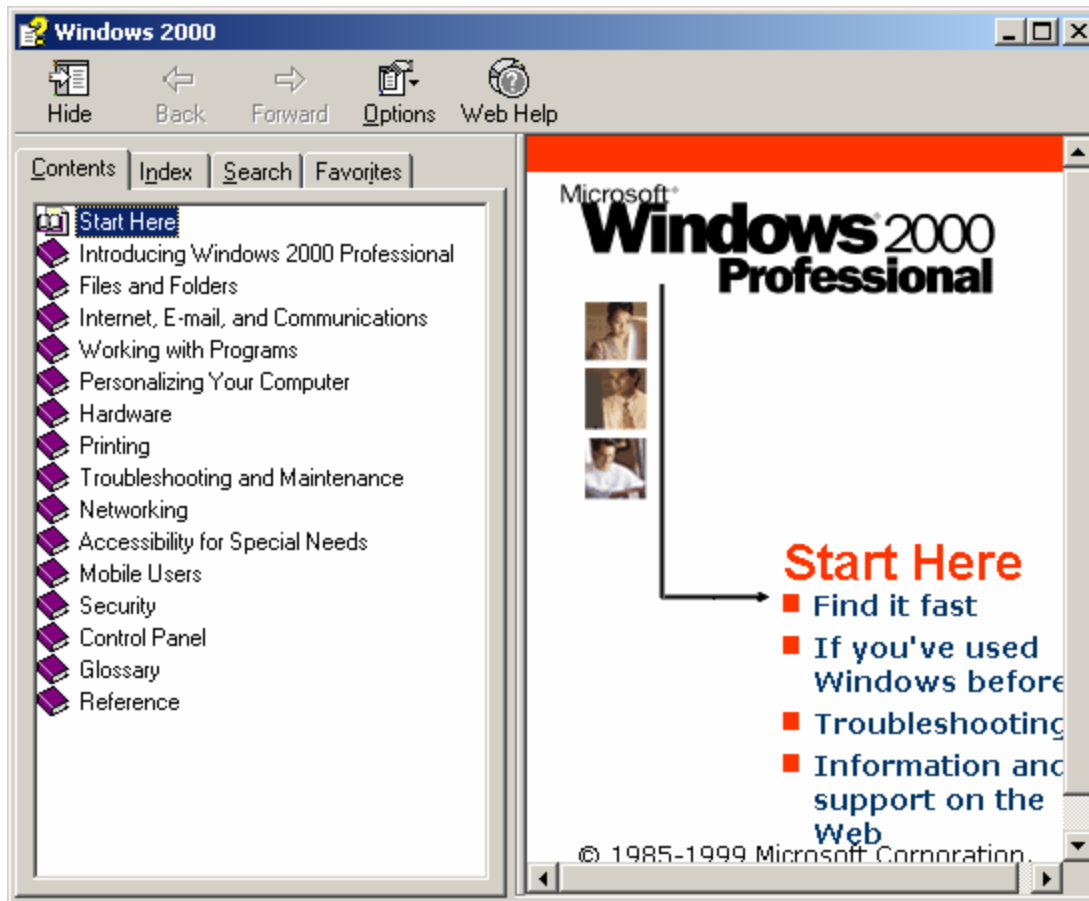


WinKey + D Shows\Hides the Desktop [Back to Page1](#)

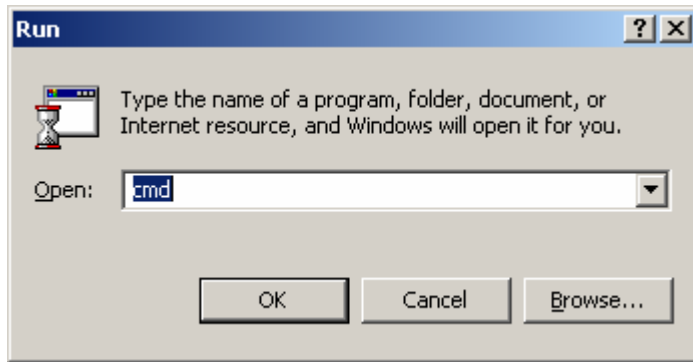
WinKey + F Finds [or Searches for] Files, Folders [Back to Page1](#)

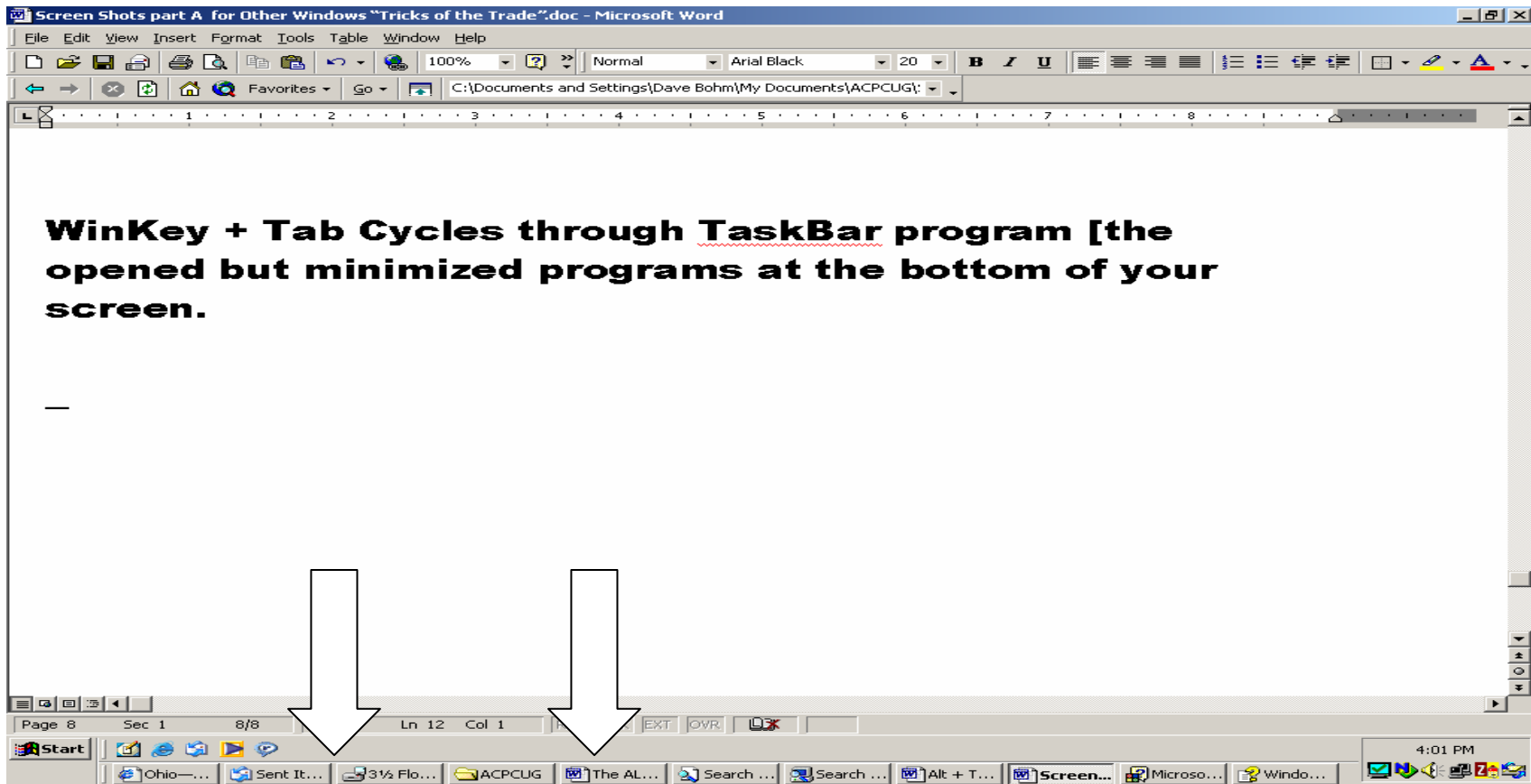


WinKey + F1 Opens Windows Help [Back to Page1](#)



WinKey + R Opens the Run dialog box [Back to Page1](#)

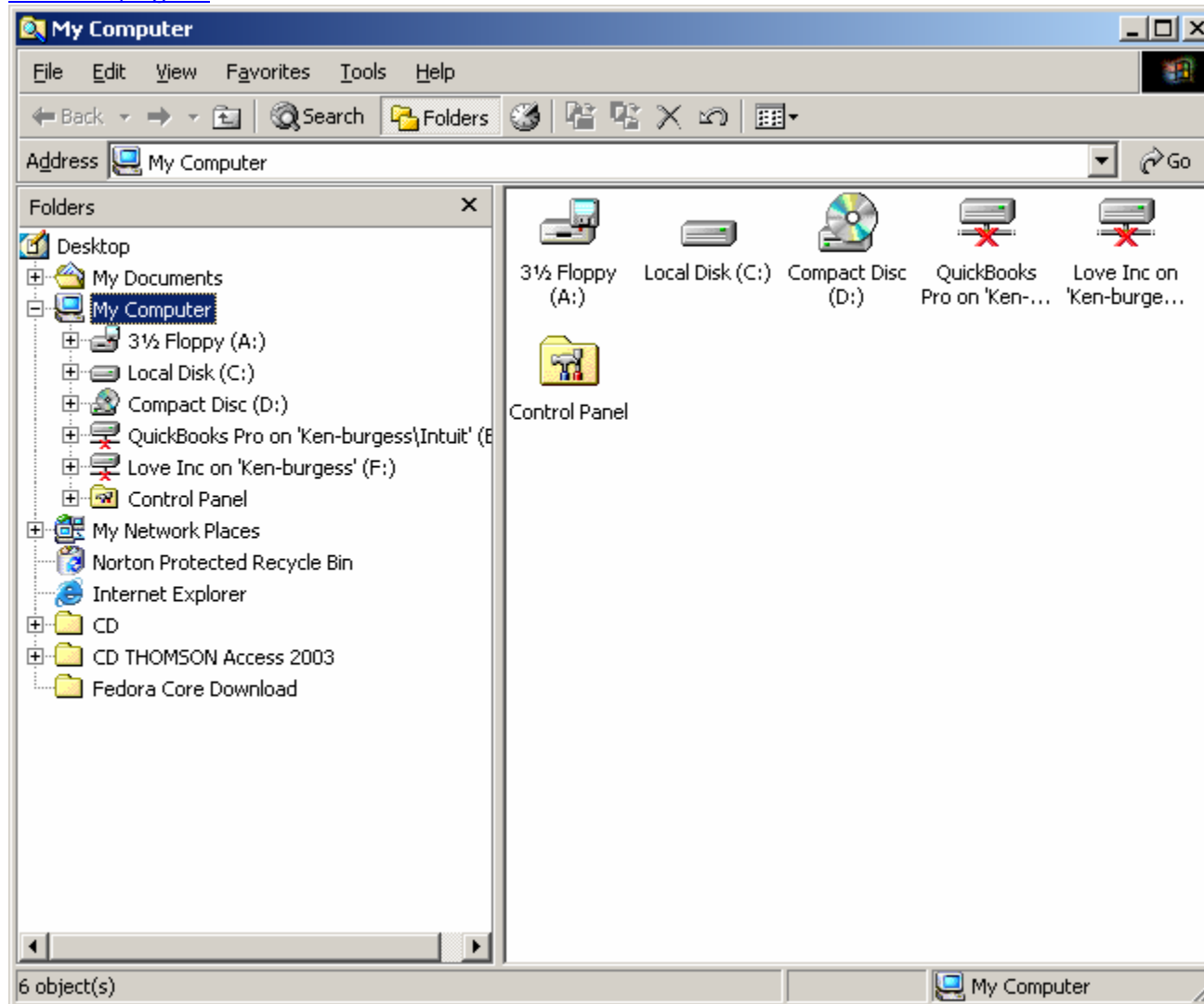




WinKey + Tab Cycles through TaskBar program [the opened but minimized programs at the bottom of your screen [back to page 2](#)
